

About this Guide

This guide only covers in detail pubs that sell at least one beer from an independent brewer. Note that both Greene King (who also own Belhaven brewery) and Marston's (who also own Banks, Brakspear, Jennings, Ringwood and Wychwood breweries) have now expanded hugely in recent years and are now classified as national brewers.

However, to encourage those pubs which try to provide a range of real ales, but have not included an independent ale, a short section at the back gives brief details of those which stock more than three or more real ales from any source.

Pubs which have made it into the Good Beer Guide 2009 have been given a photograph.

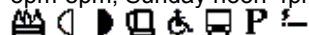

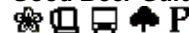
